History

The New Court Seminar Room is located within the distinctive New Court building at Christ's College, Cambridge, a striking example of Brutalist architecture designed by Sir Denys Lasdun in 1969–70.

Positioned next to the Darwin Garden, the building is officially known as New Court but is more widely referred to as the “Typewriter” due to its unique, angular design.
